Potential presenters are invited to submit an abstract of no more than one page in length to EDAS (<http://edas.info>). Each abstract should summarize results of the research or development and explain the significance of the contribution. Presenters are encouraged to use the I²MTC Industrial Applications Track Presentation Guidelines, which can be found on the conference website at <http://imtc.ieee-ims.org>. Please check that website for detailed instructions, and make note of the following deadlines:

- **January 8, 2010** for the submission of abstracts and intent to present
- **February 1, 2010** for the notification of authors on the acceptance or rejection of abstracts
- **March 1, 2010** for the submission of registration fees
- **March 15, 2010** for submission of PowerPoint presentations for inclusion on the Industry Presentations CD

The abstracts will be reviewed by the Technical Program Committee. At least one of the authors of an accepted abstract must register for the Conference, pay the registration fees, attend the Conference, and give the presentation. Submitted presentations will be published as part of the Industry Presentations CD when accompanied by a registration fee for at least one of the authors.

Presentations should focus on unique applications of measurement technologies and should not contain marketing information. If you are interested in marketing your products, please contact the Conference Exhibit Co-Chairs, Sue Kingston and Chris Dyer.

Individuals interested in submitting full-length papers for presentation in the regular sessions and for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings CD should submit extended abstracts for the Regular I²MTC Session tracks as part of the I²MTC Call for Papers.
