

Best Application in I&M Award Guidelines

Award

- One award of \$500.00 USD
- Paper certificate
- Publication of the idea on the IEEE IMS Magazine

Purpose of the Award

- Recognize an individual whose idea applies measurement concepts or instrumentation technology in a novel way to benefit society. The application must be a working solution to an engineering need or problem.

Eligibility

- Candidate must be a Member (or higher-grade Member) or a Student Member of the IEEE and of the I&M Society at the time of accepting the Award.
- Previous Award recipients are not eligible for a period of two years after receiving the award.
- No more than one nomination per candidate will be considered.

Conditions of the Award

- Winning candidate must submit a written article, suitable for publication in the IEEE IMS Magazine no later than 6 months following the awarding.

Timetable/Selection Process

- The complete electronic application package must be submitted to the I&M Society Application Award Selection Committee Chair no later than October 1st, 2015
- The Application Award committee will operate via e-mail and teleconferences.
- Award recipients will be announced and awards handed out (or sent) during the I²MTC Conference following the application deadline.

Selection Committee

- The committee consist of three members: (1) EdCom Member (appointed by the EdCom Chair) who will chair the Selection committee, (1) Magazine Associate Editor (appointed by the Editor in chief of the IMS Magazine), (1) Membership Committee Member (appointed by the Membership Committee Chair).
- The committee members serve for a two-year term (staggered, after the formation of the committee for the very first time). The Chair serves a two-year term.

- The committee members will select the candidate application that best applies I&M principles in an innovative way and delivers impact for the society membership.

Electronic Application Package

The nomination package must include the following separate files:

- Filled out nomination template (available at <http://ieee-ims.org/education/education>)
- Résumé of the nominee (max. 1 page)
- Detailed description of the application, application process or apparatus (max. 3 pages)
- Description of the impact of the application and how it applies I&M principles (max. 1 page)
