This year, DLP Evaluations will be conducted in-person and virtually on Zoom on Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, at I<sup>2</sup>MTC 2025 in Chemnitz, Germany. In-person presentations are preferred, and virtual presentations will be conducted live with the Evaluation Committee in the time zone of the conference (CEST or UTC +2).

Applications are accepted through May 4, 2025 (11:59pm CDT/UTC-5). Presentations submitted for an evaluation slot *must be no longer* than 12 minutes. Q&A sessions will not be permitted as part of the presentation, and the evaluation schedule with assigned timeslots for May 20<sup>th</sup> will be provided to each applicant via email by May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Suggested topics for DL presentations include (but are not limited to):

- Laser/Optics (including Fiber Optic Sensing)
- Measurement Precision, Sensitivity, and Noise
- Measurement Fundamentals (accuracy, trueness, repeatability, resolution, etc.)
- Calibration and Calibration Periodicity
- DC Measurements
- Biomedical Instrumentation and Measurements
- Robotics/Automated Measurements
- Nanotechnology in Instrumentation and Measurement
- Big Data and Metrology
- Measurement for Food Safety
- State-of-the-Art of Traditional Measurements and Instrumentation (Digitizers, Voltmeters, Spectrum Analyzers, etc.).

- Presenter's name and affiliation
- Presentation mode (in-person or virtual)
- Abstract of the presentation topic (between 500 and 1000 words)
- A biography of the presenter (limited to 150 words)
